Publication principles and guidelines for writing

GENERAL GUIDELINES FOR WRITING

- 1. A minimum of 150 words and a maximum of 200 words in all manuscripts should be provided in Turkish and English abstracts. Key words consisting of at least 3 and at most 5 words under the abstracts should be given in abstractlanguage.
- 2. The parts that should be emphasized in the text should be written in italicletters and the quotations should be written in italicsand given in quotation marks. Dark characters should not be usedunlessrequired.
- 3. The margins should be 3' cm. And the pages should not be numbered.
- 4. The guidelines for writing issued by the Turkish LanguageInstitution should be taken into account for the writing of the words.
- 5. The page layout of the texts to be added to the system must be made by the author and in accordance with the following rules for margins:
- A- Paper Size: A4 Vertical (Horizontal pages should not be included.)

B- Upper Margin: 2.5 cm C- Lower Margin: 2.5 cm D- Left Margin: 2.5 cm E Right Margin: 2.5 cm

- F- Font: Word 6.0 and above for Windows with Times New Roman font should be writtenpapers which are used in a special font should bein that file and be sent along with the text.
- G- Text Size must be 11 in the title, 11 in the text, 10 in the abstract and 9 puntos in the footnotes
- H- Paragraphspacing: 6 nkbefore 0 nkafter
- I- Line Spacing: 1 in the text, 1 in the footnotes.
- J- The headline of the manuscriptsmust be written in capitalletters at the beginning of the first page, and the subheadings should be written in bold with the first letters in capitals. All titles should be written in bold. The names and surnames of authors, academictitles, work places, corresponding addresses must be written just below the title.
- K- The abstracts of the manuscripts in English and Turkish and theirkeywordsmustbe shown in 10 pointsunder the authors' names and address information.

WRITING GUIDELINES FOREXPERIMENTAL PUBLICATIONS

Sections and sub-sections

- The main text should be composed of the following sections INTRODUCTION, METHOD, FINDINGS, DISCUSSION, CONCLUSION and RECOMMENDATIONS.
- 2. Headingshould not be specified in numbers, it should be in the form of chaptertitle, lower, middle and sub-headings
- 3. The tableheadings should be written on the chart, the drawing and pictureheadings should be writtenunder the drawing and the picture. The first letters of the table, drawing and pictureheadings should be in capitals.

Source Listing& referencing

- 1. The sourcelisting& bibliography should be in accordance with the APA standards as described in the Journal of the American Psychological Association, 5th Edition, 2001). The source list & bibliography should be at the end of the article.
